First you must unzip/clone to usb stick ( I use a plain-jane 512Mb Kennsington USB thumb drive or stick) and then insert the right files into the ssh folder and you should be gold. As I said there are full instrucs.

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I tried to make this as painless as possible.

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Well. This is another issue.

The 'file structure' on the DMG is MAC. ANd has to stay that way. Regardless of whether or not the image was compressed or not when zipped makes no difference in this case.

So, You will have to use a mac in order to 'clone' the DMG to a USB stick./ period.

There may be ways to do this on a PC but I know nothing about that and 1 thing is for sure...

you cannot convert this disk image and have it work. why ? because the image is exactly the way it needs to be in order to boot the ATV.

You should be able to - on a windows box - unzip the file successfully.

Cloning it to the USB stick most likely has to be done on a mac. sorry.

Interfacing with the ATV can be done through a windows machine but the actual creation of the stick should be done on a mac.

Can you unzip the image and see it ok ? and if so it should be 22 MB in size.

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Yes. Exactly. I doubt their will be a problem with the compressed image. Just an outside chance.

You just :

1. format the usb stick as 'Mac OS Extended (Journaled)'
2. the use an app like super-duper as your URL shows : that will essentially clone the contents of the disk image to the usb stick.

If you look at the image I sent - in the "Replace this text file with Binaries referenced within" file - INSIDE the installer.d folder - there are FULL instructions as to what to do - and I went further for those who are nubbies so they had some idea of how to go about things after having a working patchstick - as that is simply step 1.

You will need to use whatever windows app will allow you to login to the ATV using ssh -1 (bash shell.)

It "may" not be necessary to clone - however - in my experience there are often many invisible files - and cloning makes sure you get everything - including the right privelegs attached to the files.

In the beginning the idea was to clone - so that - the entire stick would be - copy-able. However as it turns out the stick HAS to be 'created' using the old method - the FIRST part of the kit I sent you.

At least you have the OS Boot Take 2 image. I'll have to work out how to include it in my kit - but its 160 Mb so it's kinda large.

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You HAVE to first create the patchstick on your TIGER ( you can use Leopard but it's not recommended ) machine BY :

1. Mounting the OS Boot Take 2 image.
2. Then use the 'createPatchstick' kit to make the stick.
3. Then you CLONE my patchstick after creating it
4. Now put the required missing files on the patchstick (as per my instructions )(get the SSH files from a TIGER INTEL mac )

done.

... then it has to work.

Let me know how it goes.

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I think that ATV4Windows image should work just fine. I know its worked for people here. Also - the boot stuff I think you are referring to should be the same for both platforms - as the boot info is for the ATV and not a win machine - the windows difference on the stick - I think - are the SMB related files that allow the windows machine to ssh into the ATV once successfully patch using this stick.

Try it out. I recommend the 'cone method' so if possible clone that win patchstick image to the stick once you have 'createPatchstick' completed. Even if you are in Leopard it 'might' still work if you clone the image to the stick ...

I think when you run the createPatchstick routine ( Even in Leopard) that the directory structure on the patchstick will be created ... which is key - and you will have the OSBoot image mounted in the finder as required by the createPatchstick script.

So after creating the stick ( maybe you have already done this step ) then

clone the ATV4Windows image you have to the stick and then try that.  
Might not work but it might. I'll try and get a sec to look again - it's been 4ever since I was at this.

I have tried several different brands of flash drives (I just tried a 2 gig Lexar tonight), and several different sizes. I am using an intel imac with 10.4.9, the 2.02 atv image (2z694-5428-3), the combo 10.4.9 updater image mounted, and an

original imac intel Tiger install dvd mounted. Every time I try to create a patchstick I get the following results.
